

**PEKELILING PENGARAH TANAH DAN GALIAN SELANGOR
BILANGAN 2/1963**

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**APPEAL UNDER SECTION 38 OF THE LAND
ACQUISITION ACT 1950**

The procedures followed by Collectors of Land Revenue when dealing with an application that an objection be referred to Court under section 38 (l) of the above Act have hitherto been varied. As it is necessary that all actions on such applications be speeded up and that the Legal Adviser is informed at the earliest possible opportunity of such an appeal the following procedure must be followed:

- (I) On receipt of an objection in form N the Collector will immediately forward a copy of it to the Legal Adviser with, if necessary a separate memorandum to explain the case involved where information in form and N is considered inadequate:
- (ii) The Collector will process to call for deposit and to prepare Form O in draft. Reference must be made to the Chief Valuation Office Lee Yan Lien Building, Kuala Lumpur, if necessary:
- (iii) When draft form O is ready he will at once forward it together with the file in the subject to the commissioner of land =s & Mines, Selangor, for transmission to the Legal Adviser:
- (iv) The draft will only be issued when vetted by the Legal Adviser and not otherwise.

2. The above procedure will not absolve each Collector from observing Circular No 4/61 issued by the commissioner Of Lands, Federation of Malaya.
